FIM Levels

Independence (No helper)

- 7 Complete Independence (Timely, Safely)
- 6 Modified Independence (Device)
- 5 Supervision (Exception)

Modified Dependence (Helper)

- 5 Supervision (Subject = 100%+)
- 4 Minimal Assist (Subject = 75%+)
- 3 Moderate Assist (Subject = 50%+)

Complete Dependence

- 2 Maximal Assist (Subject = 25%+)
- 1 Total Assist (Subject = less than 25%)

The FIM score represents an estimated daily burden of care. These guidelines should be used in conjunction with the clinical judgment and collaboration from the care team to determine care needs.
