Helpful Holiday Hints

- Ask your patients to call you first before going to the emergency department
- Communicate your holiday hours now, such as updating your voicemail, posting signage and talking with your patients
- Let patients know their options for when your office is closed, including: an after-hours call line; medimap.ca for walk-in and UPCC clinic information; a pharmacist; HealthlinkBC 8-1-1; or Urgent and Primary Care Centres in their area for urgent, same-day care conditions (visit www.vch.ca/UPCC for more information)
- Remind patients to ask that a copy of their medical reports be sent to you
